Manju Goel challenges opponent to public debate on Obamacare

Proposes three forums, also focusing on jobs and cutting government

Carol Stream, Illinois – Manju Goel, Republican candidate for Congress in the 8th Congressional district, is asking her opponent to agree to three public debates before the primary election, with an emphasis on ending Obamacare, as well as jobs and cutting government.

“Campaigns are about ideas and about which candidate has the skill and background to best represent the people,” Goel said in a letter sent today to Larry Kaifesh. “There is no better way for voters to judge this than to see and hear the candidates side by side, talking about the key issues and answering questions.

In her campaign, Goel has been endorsed by conservatives such as former Congressman Joe Walsh, current members Rodney Davis and Aaron Schock, former National Republican Congressional Committee Chairman Pete Sessions of California and former Reagan campaign director Don Totten.

Goel grew up in a middle class family in northern India and came to the U.S. during the Reagan Revolution. She earned degrees in Applied Computer Science and Health Care Management and served as a Process Improvement Specialist for over five years at Advocate Healthcare, where she achieved a 37.7% improvement in physician efficiency, saving over \$3 million dollars. Goel is now a self-employed consultant specializing in process control improvement.

In her letter to Kaifesh, Goel suggested their campaigns work out debate details. She proposed the following debate topics:
